

FORMAT FOR TECHNICAL PAPER

1. Title
Should be in bold Letter
2. Authorship
There is no restriction on number of authors, but we believe that a maximum of four (4) Authors is desired Associates should be covered by acknowledgements. The name(s) of author(s) should be accompanied by the name of the institution they represent, which should be marked at the end of the first page of paper.
3. Abstract
The abstract of the paper may be placed (not more than 200 words) after the title/ author heading
4. Introduction
The introduction may contain overall purpose of the paper and provide information on the previous work or experience on the theme of the paper
5. Main Body of the Paper
Main body of the paper should consists of the following sections:-
 - (a) Material and Methods
 - (b) Results
 - (c) Discussions
 - (d) Summary of Conclusion and Recommendation
6. Length
Length of paper mat be limited to 3500 words, plus necessary tables and figures
7. Acknowledge
Where authors desire, they may include a short section of acknowledgements.
8. Reference / Review of Literature
To be written in systematic manner that is Name of Author(s), Year of Publication, Title of Paper / Book, Publisher/Magazine, Page No.(s) etc.
9. Subject Matter
Contents must be previously un-printed, appropriately relevant to sugar technology and agriculture, of sufficient Technical/Scientific worth and without undue commercial bias.
10. Final Copy
Complete paper should be e-mailed directly to The President PSSST at gm@aasml.com, & cc to gssugar@gmail.com in Microsoft Word, with all the text, data, tables and figures as one file. If e-mail is not available three typed copies plus CD must be supplied. Tables must be kept to a minimum number, be in portrait format and the maximum size of each table should be A4.
